

Sir,

Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA) is implementing a project on "Capacity building of Indian Forest Service officers on Biodiversity Conservation with special reference to Aquatic, Coastal and Marine Biodiversity with the assistance of UNDP. The main objective of this project is development of a comprehensive module on this theme along with piloting and development of study material. One of the components of the project is to organize a 3 day workshop on the module prepared for in-service IFS officers working in coastal states/UTs.
