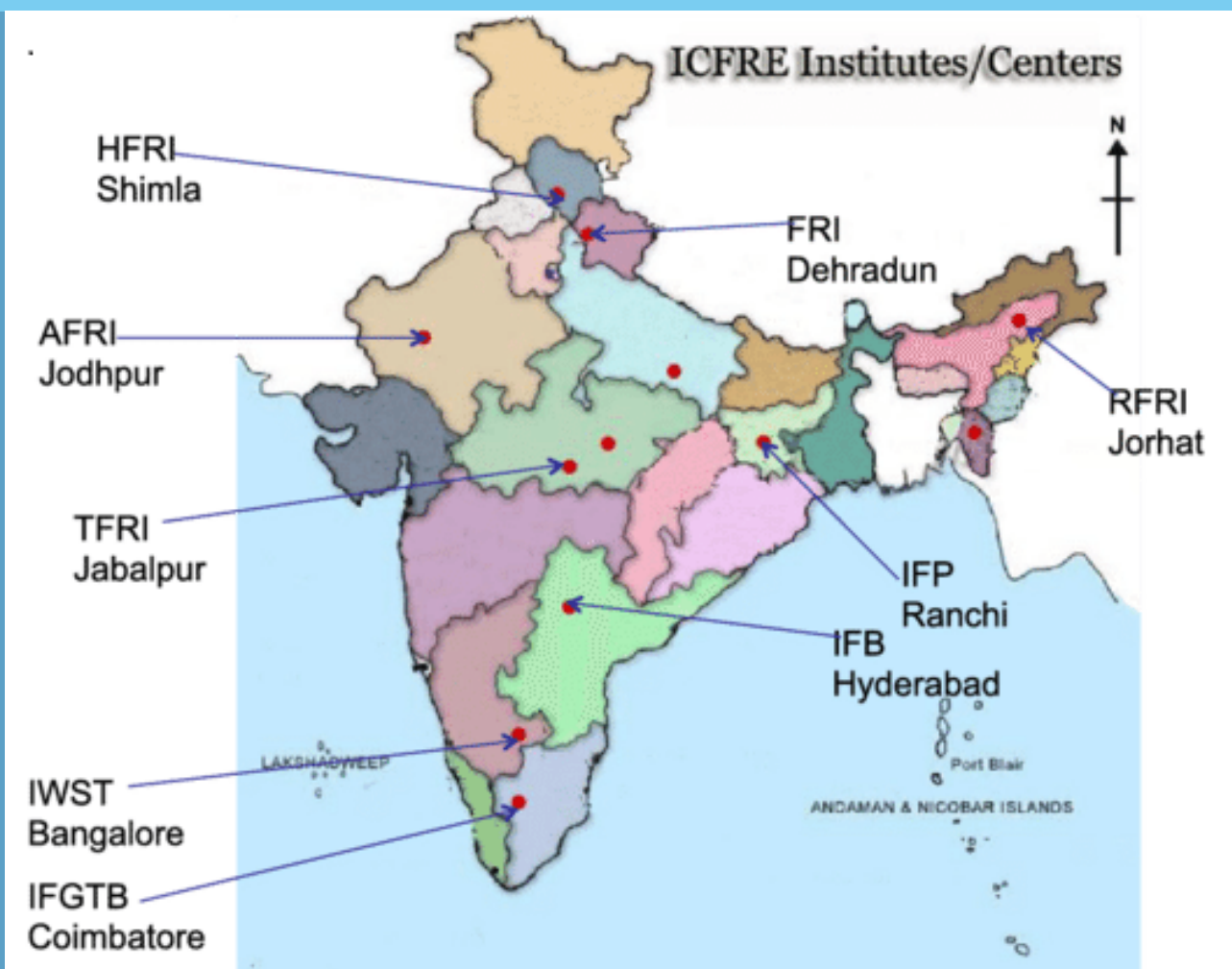

an apex body in the national forestry research system has a pan India presence with its 9 Regional Research Institutes



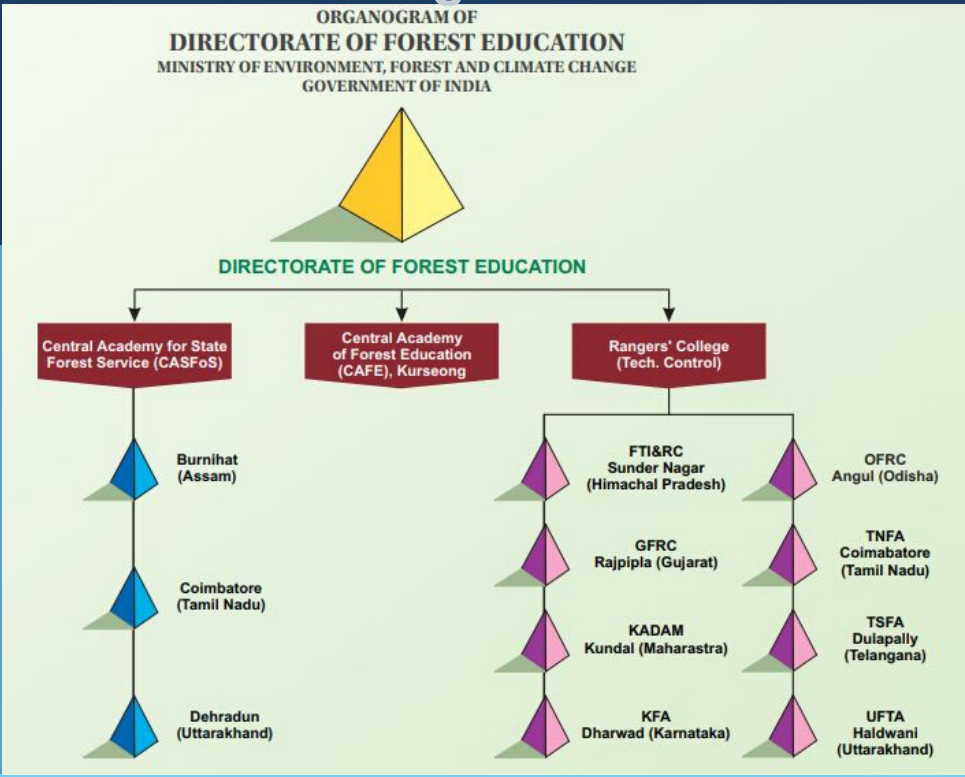
ICFRE - few ongoing work areas
