Sub: Nominations of IFS Officers promoted from SFS to the Indian Forest Service for 29th Professional Skill Up-gradation (PSU) Course in 2015 scheduled from 16th November 2015 to 22nd January 2016 at IGNFA-reg.

Your kind attention is invited to our Letter No. 481/2015-NFA/PSUC-2015 dated 09.06.2015 where the cut off age for the eligibility had been mentioned to be 52 years of age as on 01.01.2016 for IFS Officers promoted from SFS in attending Induction Training of Professional Skill Upgradation Course (PSUC) at IGNFA. This age limit is being changed from 52 years to 54 years as per provision of Regulation 7(3) of IFS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulation 1966.

It is therefore requested that the eligible officers of your state, who have not undergone the course and who do not attain age of 54 years on 01.01.2016, may be nominated and appropriate action to relieve them in time with course fee to join the training at IGNFA on 16th November 2015 may be taken at the earliest.

The course fee of Rs. 1,75,000 (Rs. One Lakh Seventy Five Thousand Only) per participant is payable to the academy and the same may be sent in form of Demand Draft payable in favour of "The Director, IGNFA", at Dehradun, on advance basis.
