Sub: Phase- IV (8) Mid-Career Training programme for Indian Forest Service officers regarding

Sir,

This is to inform you that as a part of civil services reforms approved by the Hon'ble Prime Minister for the three All India Services, viz., IAS, IPS & IFS, the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, GoI (MoEF&CC) has approved conduct of Phase IV Mid Career Training programmes for IFS officers of 16-18 years seniority, The eighth course of Phase IV MCT programme for the IFS officers of 1997, 1998 & 1999 batches is proposed to be organized by IGNA in the year 2015 – 16, as per the schedule given as under:-

2. IGNA has finalized the list to nominations for the aforesaid 8th Course of Phase IV programme excluding who has less than three years of service left after the year in which he/she is supposed to undergo MCT as well as those who have not completed PSUC on promotion from SFS. In this process, it is observed that the following officer of your state has not attended the MCT (IV) programmes.

Therefore, the officer to whom second nomination becoming available in 2015 after postponement of his participation earlier, he may be allowed and directed under intimation to IGNA to mandatorily register himself online for MCT Phase IV training in 2015.

3. As the above training programmes are being organized in association with National/International institutions and also involve two-week foreign visit as well as training at other national level Institutions like IIMs, the participation of individual officer needs to be confirmed well in advance both by the concerned states as well as by the participants themselves. This may kindly be done latest by **31.05.2015**. It is also mentioned that keeping in view the international commitments involved in the conduct of the training programme, it would not be possible to change a confirmed nomination to the training programme.

4. You are requested to direct the concerned officers about the programme details and ask them to be in complete readiness. As the Academy has enabled the facility of online registration at its website (www.ignfa.gov.in), the officers may also be directed to register online immediately. **The**


most important requirement for all the participating officers would be to get their official passports ready from the Regional Passport Officers located in your State. The officer can either use authority of this letter or respective State Govt. letters for issuance of official passport from Regional Passport Office or approach the IGNFA on an urgent basis to make available the political clearance issued by MEA. The visa formalities can be completed by the Academy/MoEF&CC, only for those officers, who have obtained the official passport in time and have intimated the Academy accordingly. The participating officers may kindly be directed to follow the above requirements well in time.

Further, the States are also requested to take advance action to ensure release of the nominated officers in time to enable them to attend the training programme on 17 August, 2015 at 09 AM at IIM, Lucknow. **During the programme, the participants will be provided single accommodation and under no circumstances the family members would be allowed to accompany during the entire training programme including study visit abroad. Officers must also not carry any liability during the period of 17.8.2015 to 09.10.2015 for absents from the training. This may clearly be brought to the notice of officers so that they do not face embarrassment of return of their families from places of training including foreign countries.**

5. Further, it is worth mentioning that the Indian Forest Service (Pay) Rules have been revised vide notification no. 20011/1/2006-AIS-II dated 21.02.2008 and its amendment through IFS (Pay) Second Amendment Rules, 2008 vide notification no. 14021/3/2008-AIS-II dated 27.09.2008, to make successful completion of these MCT programmes compulsory for award of Junior Administrative grade, IInd Super time scale and further increments to the concerned officers. Therefore, it would be the responsibility of the concerned State Government and the officers themselves to be in a position to attend the programme on first offer only as per the schedule. Failure to attend the said training, without express approval of MoEF&CC, would mandatorily attract the consequences laid down in the IFS (Pay) Rules, for which this Academy or the MoEF&CC shall not be responsible.
