Your kind attention is invited to the letter cited under reference (Copy enclosed) whereby nominations were invited for Mid Career Training Phase – V (13) Programme of IFS officers with 26-28 year of seniority (1986-88 batch). Pursuant to that, the following officer had registered with the IGnFA for the Programme.

The IGnFA is now conducting the MCT Phase – V (13) Programme as per the revised schedule given below and has already initiated action to obtain political clearance for above mentioned officer.

In this regard, you are requested to direct the concerned officer about the Programme details and ask him to be in complete readiness along with his official passport, issued by competent authority located in your state to attend the program as per the revised schedule. They may also be directed to furnish the details of the official passport to the Academy at the earliest to complete the visa formalities on time.

Further, the States are also requested to take advance action to ensure release of the nominated officer in time to enable him to attend the training programme. **During the Programme, the participant will be provided single accommodation and under no circumstances the family members would be allowed to accompany during the entire Training Programme including study visit abroad. This may clearly be brought to the notice of officer so that he does not face embarrassment of return of his family from places of training including foreign countries.**

Further, it is worth mentioning that the Indian Forest Service (Pay) Rules have been revised vide notification no. 20011/1/2006-AIS-II dated 21.02.2008 and its amendment through IFS (Pay) Second Amendment Rules, 2008 vide notification no. 14021/3/2008-AIS-II dated 27.09.2008, to make successful completion of these MCT Programmes compulsory for award of promotions to the concerned officers. Therefore, it would be the responsibility of the concerned State Government and the officers themselves to be in a position to attend the programme as per the schedule. Failure to attend the said training, without express approval of MoEF&CC, would mandatorily attract the consequences laid down in the IFS (Pay) rules, for which this Academy or the MoEF&CC shall not be responsible.

Sub: Mid Career Training Programme for IFS Officers- Regarding Phase V

Sir,

The reference is drawn to the letter no. 499/MCT/2014/ Ph-V-13 dated 18.06.2014 on the subject of mandatory Mid Career Training Programme (MCTP) participation in Phase V during 2013 and during 2014 to the IFS Officers of AGMU cadre in Arunachal Pradesh State with year of allotment of 1987. The participation in MCTP is of mandatory nature and linked with promotion/ increment as per the India Forest Service (Pay) Rules. No exemption is also entertained by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change. Three number of chances are made available to an eligible Officer to complete MCT. On postponement of participation after second chance, inclusion of an officer's name for third chance is based on prior concurrence of the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India with the circumstances of non-participation earlier to be recommended by the State Government.

The Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA) is organising MCT Phase V during 2015 from the 29th March 2015 to 25th April 2015. The IGNFA is also initiating the process of obtaining political clearance for already registered eligible officers on first option availed in 2014 for MCTP in 2015.

Following eligible officers of 1987 batch in AGMU cadre did not avail the first chance for enrolment online with the Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy, Dehradun (www.ignfa.gov.in). They are being provided second chance for enrolment in 2015.

Therefore, for second option becoming available in 2015 after postponement of their participation earlier, he may be allowed and directed to mandatorily register themselves online for MCT Phase V training in 2015.

Details of attending the MCT Phase V on confirmation of online registration would be communicated to the State Government for releasing officer(s) to join the MCT on due date and venue.
