

**IMPORTANT JOINING INSTRUCTIONS & FULL ITINERARY OF
PHASE-II (2) MCT PROGRAM**

Dear Participant,

Please note the following information for the programme.

JOINING/REPORTING

1. The course will be inaugurated at 9.00 AM on 27th March, 2017 at IGNFA, Dehradun. All the nominated officers are to report positively at IGNFA latest by the 26th March, 2017 for participation in Phase-II (2) training. IGNFA shall get in touch with you for reception etc.

2. The programme would be completely residential. Lodging and boarding facilities at IGNFA, Dehradun would be arranged by IGNFA. During foreign travel lodging will be provided by concerned universities. Normally single accommodation is provided. However, during field trips, sometimes shared accommodation (double occupancy basis) may also be arranged due to limited availability of accommodation. All travel arrangements during the course **(Except journey for reporting to the programme venue i.e. IGNFA & return journey from Dehradun after the programme)** would be made by IGNFA.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

3. Medical insurance is a mandatory requirement for the period of foreign module. The medical facilities are very costly abroad and it is extremely difficult to settle medical expense without insurance. Though IGNFA makes arrangements for all participants to be covered under the 'Assisted Medical Attendance' scheme of MHA, GoI during the foreign trip. Yet the past experience shows that this channel is often not accessible, particularly in times of need. **So, participants are strongly advised to get themselves covered under "Travel/Health Insurance" from any reputed vendor, e.g. ICICI Lombard etc., additionally before proceeding on foreign visit. Since, this is a major mandatory requirement by the foreign governments, the universities will insist on this before the commencement of programme. Kindly send a copy of medical insurance receipt to the course coordinators prior to the commencement of the programme.**

WEATHER/CLOTHING/ACCESSORIES

4. The weather would be pleasant at Dehradun during the programme period but as the officers would also be traveling to Finland/Russia during the course, it is advised that they carry sufficient warm clothing for themselves. (1-2 Pullovers & inners, 1 Blazer for official/semiofficial get-togethers and one rain proof jacket). The temperatures in Helsinki and Moscow are likely to be in the range of (2⁰ C to 7⁰ C) during our stay.
