Sub: Nominations of the Indian Forest Service (IFS) officers for One-Week Compulsory Training Course on **"Best Practices in Forestry"** scheduled to be held at **Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy (IGNFA), Dehradun in virtual/online mode** from **January 11-15, 2021** - reg.

Sir,

Please find enclosed a (scanned copy) of the list of IFS officers (along with a copy of the letter addressed to the institute) from your State/Organization who have been nominated to participate in the above mentioned compulsory training course. It may kindly be ensured that all the officers nominated by the Government of India (GoI) will participate in the course. **The Institute has instructions to accept only the officers nominated by the GoI.** Your co-operation in making this in-service training programme a success is solicited. The following guidelines regarding participation in the courses sponsored by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) may kindly be brought to the notice of all the IFS officers: -

- a. The officers who have just passed out of IGNEFA and are undergoing mandatory attachments in States may be nominated after one year.
- b. The Batches undergoing/undergone MCT programmes may be nominated.
- c. The senior batches who are in the Apex Scale may also be nominated for trainings/workshops.
- d. The institutions have been given instructions to forward in original the attendance sheet of the participants. The officers, who have not been serious in participating in the course, will not be nominated for training course(s) for the next one year.
- e. The State Governments/ PCCFs/ officers are requested to intimate the Ministry immediately in case an officer is nominated for a training course/workshop at a station where he/she has been nominated for a training course/workshop during the last three years.
- f. The officer may be nominated both in one-week training and two-day workshop during a particular financial year.
- g. The lists are normally prepared and communicated to two and a half months in advance to the State Governments and the Institutes. Requests for additions/ change will be entertained after the approval of DIGF (RT), MoEF&CC, New Delhi.
- h. In order to ensure full participation of the nominated officers in the courses, it has been decided that if an officer nominated fails to participate in the training course, he/ she will not be nominated for the courses for the next one years unless the reasons for not participating were beyond the control of the officer & forwarded by the PCCF.
- i. Though every effort has been made to follow the guidelines while nominating persons, the PCCF/State govt. may take appropriate steps to rectify, if any inadvertent error is noticed.


2. **Following essential pre-conditions need to be followed at the trainee level:-**

- (i) There should be exclusive dedicated time for training period
- (ii) All the participants are desired to have a computer/laptop (to install the requisite app) with video facility (webcam), good internet connection, sufficient bandwidth to log in for video call, handset with mic, Adequate lighting at the place of seating.
- (iii) The online training is to be conducting by the institute/organisation through NIC platform "Vidyo, CISCO WEBEX, Learning Management System (LMS) by IIFM, Google Meet, Skype Meet, Zoom Software etc.
- (iv) About 3-4 online sessions will be taken in a day around 60-90 minutes (including virtual tour, case study, panel discussion, short film etc.)
- (v) A valid email id and mobile number by the trainees for coordination, e-training material etc.
