Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy, (IGNFA) is the training institute for Indian Forest Service Officers. The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, being the Cadre Controlling Authority for the Indian Forest Service, introduced Induction Training Programme of 10 weeks for the professional Skill Up-gradation Course (PSUC) of IFS officers who get inducted into the Indian Forest Service by promotion from state Forest Service. This training course is a compulsory programme for the eligible officers promoted to IFS who have not attained the age of 52 years on such appointment as per the rule 6 (3) of the IFS (Probation) Rules, 1968, on the pattern of Induction Training organized for the other two All India Services.
